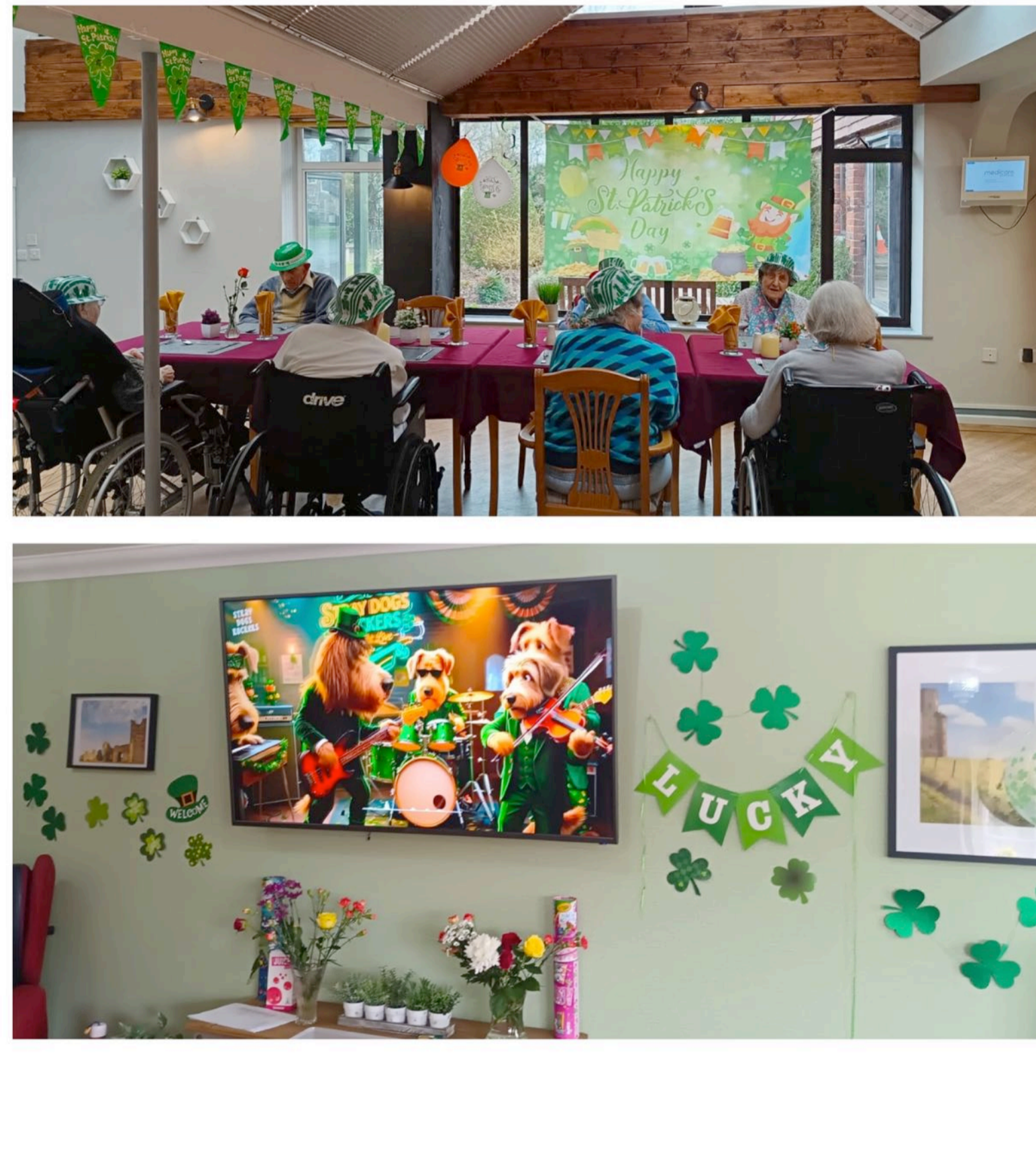

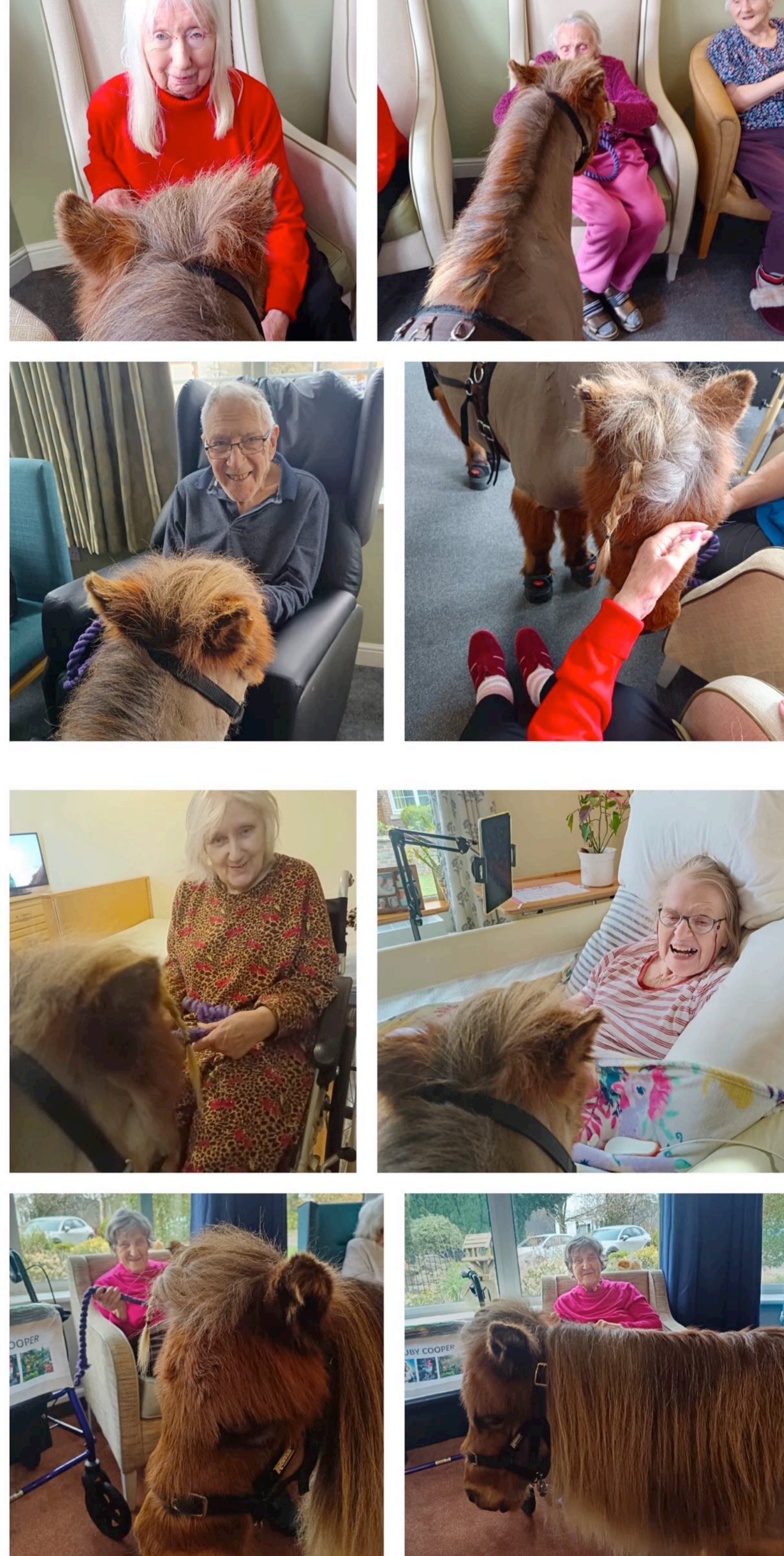


RECENT HIGHLIGHT
